5. Open discussion to address any questions or concerns.

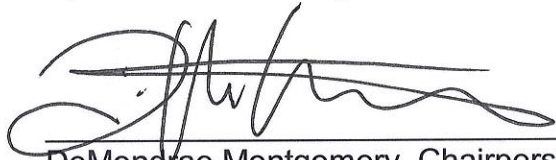
CPAC members were recommended to take Texas Open Meetings Act training.
