4. Discuss next meeting agenda items.

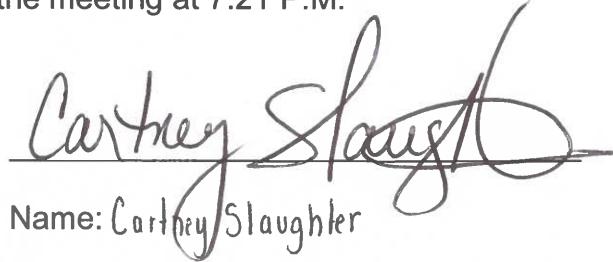
No items were discussed/added.

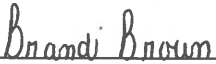
Chairperson Arlen Taliaferro adjourned the meeting at 7:21 P.M.
