Keith Moore, Director of Public Safety, introduced this item.

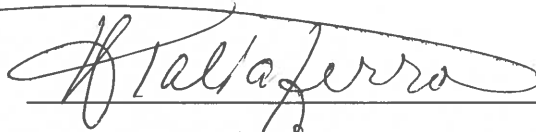
No items were discussed/added.

VOTE 5 Ayes – Slaughter, Brown, Ayers-Pruitt, Neugent, and Spencer

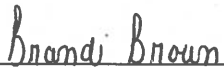
