VOTE 6 Ayes – Taliaferro, Slaughter, Brown, Ayers-Pruitt, Neugent, and Spencer

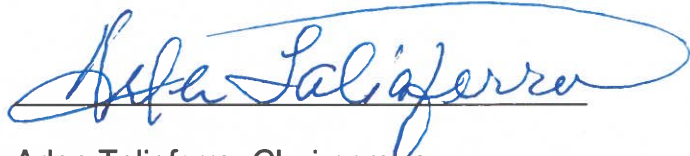
The Committee also discussed term expirations, training, and Committee Member removal.
