AGENDA

1. Discuss and take action to approve the Citizens Police Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes of the February 6, 2023, Regular Called Meeting. (Brandi Brown, City Secretary)

2. Presentation of the Glenn Heights Police Department Quarterly Crime Statistics Report.

Nick Bristow, Deputy Chief of Police, introduced this item and completed a presentation regarding dispatched calls, total calls, arrests and traffic data, calls by priority/response times, Group A crimes, and Group B crimes.

Deputy Chief Bristow answered the Committee's questions related to types of crimes, types of arrests, and when the Department sees an increase in crime rates.

3. Presentation of the Glenn Heights Police Department Quarterly Racial Profiling Report

Nick Bristow, Deputy Chief of Police, introduced this item and completed a presentation regarding contact data points, including traffic stops, race and ethnicity, street address or approximate location of stops, if searches were conducted during traffic stops and the reason why, if contraband was discovered, description of contraband located, results of stops, and motor vehicle contacts and demographics.

Deputy Chief Bristow answered the Committee's questions related to demographic information collected, the term "pre-existing knowledge", inventory processes, and if there is criteria to determine if a citation or warning will be issued.

4. Presentation of 2022-2023 Y.T.D. Citizen Complaint statistics

David Hall, City Manager, completed a presentation regarding citizen complaints including allegations, complaint dispositions, and disciplinary actions.

Mr. Hall and Mr. Moore answered the Committee's questions related to the complaint review process, progressive discipline, training, records retention, and shared data if an officer applies with another agency.

5. Discuss next meeting agenda items.

Chairperson Arlen Taliaferro introduced this item. No items were added.
