Nick Bristow, Deputy Chief of Police, introduced this item and completed a presentation regarding contact data points, including traffic stops, race and ethnicity, street address or approximate location of stops, if searches were conducted during traffic stops and the reason why, if contraband was discovered, description of contraband located, results of stops, and motor vehicle contacts and demographics.

ADJOURNMENT

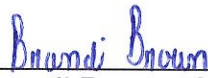
Committee Member Margo Spencer made a motion to adjourn. Committee Member LaKeisha Ayers-Pruitt made the second. The motion carried with the following vote:
