3. Discuss and review any by-laws in place for the Citizens Police Advisory Committee.

Interim Chief of Police Chris Womack introduced this item. Committee Members reviewed the Ordinance adopted by the City Council that created the CPAC. Committee Members asked if they can meet with the Executive Staff to discuss Committee goals. Interim Chief Womack discussed his request to have the Committee be more hands on, even if in a volunteer capacity. Members discussed the Secretary position and who would do this in the future. Members said they would like the meetings to be recorded so they can watch them at a later time and not keep minutes.

4. Discuss next meeting agenda items.

Members said that they would like their duties and functions compared to the duties and functions of other CPAC groups and requested the status of City Council filling Place 4.
