3. Discuss next meeting agenda items.


Committee Members requested that the Racial Profiling Presentation and a new proposed Meeting start time be added to the Agenda.

ADJOURNMENT


Committee Member Shaleese Neugent made a motion to adjourn. Committee Member Dana Williamson made the second. The motion carried with the following vote:
